SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

FORMULATION AND ACTIVE INGREDIENT: TOUCHDOWN QUATTRO is an aqueous concentrate containing 360 g/litre glyphosate, a surfactant and water conditioning system.

MAPP NUMBER: 10608.

PACK SIZE: 20 litre.

TARGETS: For the control of a wide range of annual and perennial weeds pre-harvest in Wheat, Barley, Oilseed Rape, Mustards, Linseed, Combining Peas and Field Beans, in stubbles, green cover on land temporarily removed from production and land not intended for bear vegetation, before drilling or planting any crop, for destruction of grassland and for desiccation of Oilseed Rape, Linseed and Mustards.

WATER VOLUME AND BCPC SPRAY QUALITY: Apply as a MEDIUM to COARSE quality spray. See Directions for Use for individual recommendations.
